Activity 3 - Operating a Power Hand Drill/Screwdriver

- Reviews safety handouts before beginning activity.
- Reads operator's manual before beginning activity.
- Makes sure switch is in OFF position before beginning.
- Puts on safety goggles.
- Selects correct bit and inserts in the chuck.
- Tightens the chuck to secure the bit.
- Applies the correct amount of pressure to drill a hole in the wood.
- Drills two pilot holes in the wood.
- Inserts bit into power screwdriver and drives two screws into the wood.
- Adjusts torque by increasing or decreasing the settings
- Removes all screws after completion
- Cleans area and puts away materials
