Because the young men at Liberty Point experience both intellectual disabilities and behavioral difficulties, increasing time on task is an important and challenging aspect of instruction. Over the past three years, Dr. Hartman and his staff have tracked the average daily student exits from class from over 140 to under 40 across the entire school. He attributes this marked increase in participation to student interest and to the relevancy of classroom content. 'The hands-on kits from Education Associates keep the class interested and engaged. Our time on task has increased and student disruptions have decreased significantly,' explains Dr. Hartman.
